THE CHALLENGE

To design, build and paddle a small boat
Two member teams will be allotted a maximum of
5 hours to complete their boat using only the
following supplied materials:

- 6 Tubes of Sikaflex 291 adhesive/sealant
- 3 sheets of ¼” x 4’ x 8’ Luan plywood
- 4 2” x 2” x 8’ wood
- 6 1” x 2” x 8’ wood
- 2 sawhorses
- 100 Plastic cable ties 11”

Each team is allowed the use of (but must supply themselves)
the following:

- Safety glasses
- Tape Measure
- 2 Caulking guns
- 2 Type III PDF (life preservers) for race
- Cutting pliers
- 2 extension cords
- Electric drill (suggest battery powered)
- Electric powered jig saw with blades
- 4 pair surgical gloves
- A 10’ x 10’ tent is highly recommended

THE RULES

- * No alcoholic beverage at any time
- * All boats must be bonded using Sikaflex
- * No nails or screws are allowed
- * Plastic cable ties may be used to hold the boat together
while the Sikaflex cures but must be cut prior to race
- * Both team members must participate in the building and racing
- * Boats and paddles must be made from provided materials and
no additional propulsion allowed
- * Safety glasses must be worn when using power tools
- * No templates or patterns permitted. Only a sketch on a single
sheet of 8-1/2” x 11” sheet of paper is allowed
- * Team members must be 18 yrs. old, **OR** a parent with child 12 yrs or
older
- * Type III PFD (life preservers) must be worn for the race

COVID-19 REGULATIONS

- * All CDC updated recommendations will be enforced.

The boats will be built on Saturday, August 21st from 10:00am to 3:00pm in the parking lot of Harborfront Park next to the Bayles Boat Shop
